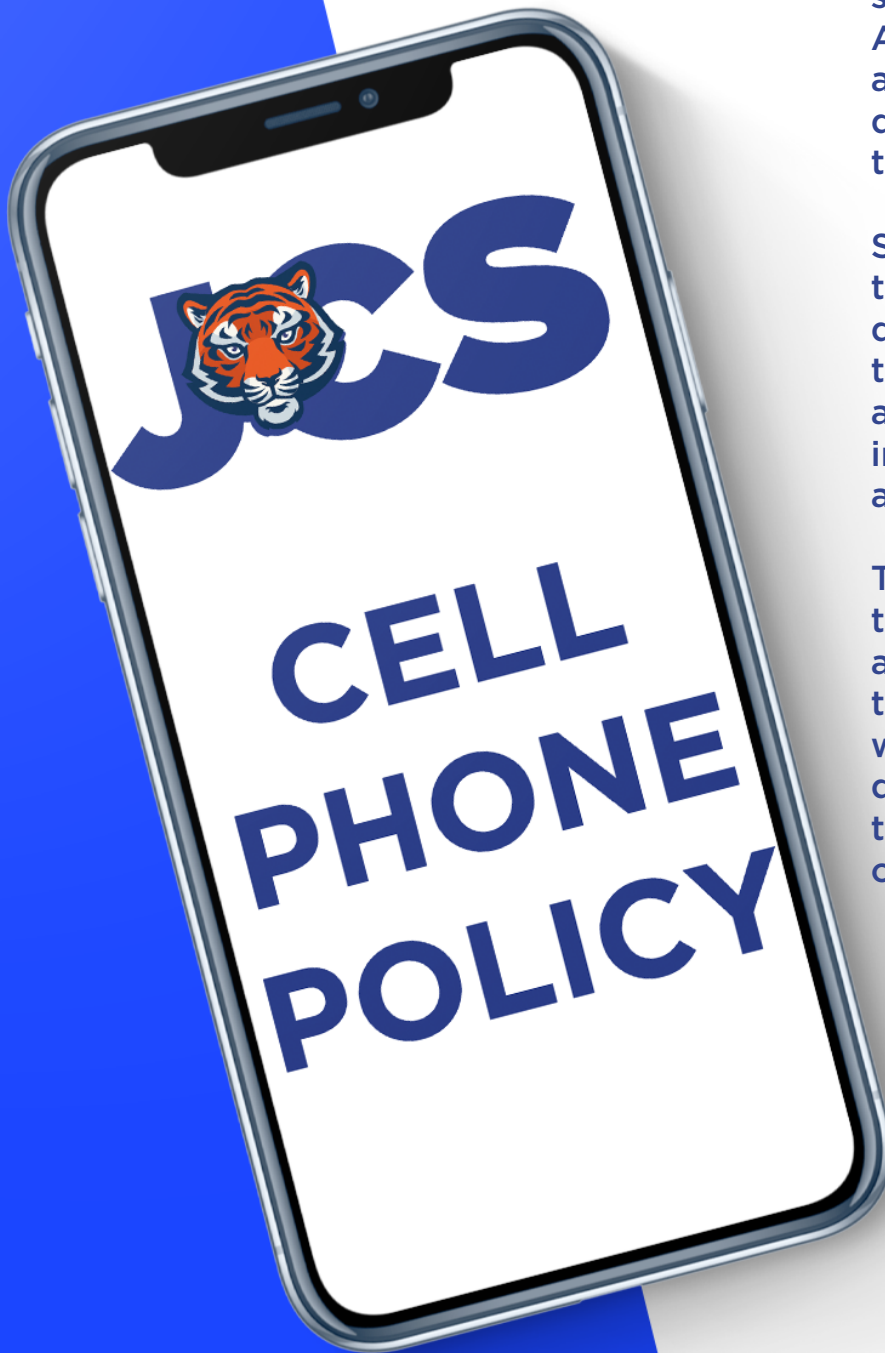


NEW CELLPHONE LEGISLATION FOR JEFFERSON K-12 TIGERS



CS/HB 379 (CH.23-26): “A student may not use a wireless communications device during instructional time, except when expressly directed by a teacher solely for educational purposes. A teacher shall designate an area for wireless communication devices during instructional time.”

Students are prohibited from the use of Tik Tok on district-owned devices, through the district’s Internet access, or as a means of communicating information from the school, athletic team, or club.

This new law also gives teachers the authority to designate an area for the student to place their cell phones and other wireless communication devices during instructional time through their classroom rules of conduct.
